Alba is the Italian name for dawn. It marks that specific time of the day, early in the morning, when the sun is below the observer's horizon and lightness is first perceived. Moments before the sun rises, a pristine sharp line emphasizing the contrast between the landscape and the horizon forms. The Alba rug is a representation of a grassland at dawn. It is woven with two different materials creating a contrasted texture design. One half is woven with a meticulously crafted wool ribbon resulting in a very subtle surface. The other half is woven with a voluminous thread of alpaca wool blend creating a more accentuated texture. Presented in three color variations, this rug is characterized by its half-and-half design and very elegant monotone color palette.


